RE: Vacancy on Judicial Ethics Advisory Committee

The purpose of this memorandum is to announce a vacancy on the Judicial Ethics Advisory Committee (JEAC). This judicial vacancy is now open and will expire on June 30, 2010. Members of the JEAC are appointed by the Judicial Discipline and Disability Commission. The JEAC was created to issue advisory opinions to judges and publicly declared candidates for judicial office. Advisory opinions address questions concerning how a future course of conduct comports with the Code of Judicial Conduct. The JEAC prepares four to twelve opinions annually. The primary writer of each opinion is selected on a rotating basis. A draft opinion is prepared and then circulated via email.

Members of the Committee consist of two retired judges or justices and one attorney who has never served as a publicly elected judicial officer. Each member serves for a three year term. The current opening is for a retired judge or justice.
